Nakba Day is the day we commemorate the Palestinian Catastrophe in 1948, when 750,000 people - half the population of British Mandatory Palestine - were forced from their homes or made to flee, first by Zionist paramilitaries, who poisoned Palestinian wells and perpetrated dozens of massacres; then after the establishment of "Israel" in May 1948, by its military. Four hundred towns and villages were entirely obliterated; 130 others were simply stolen, given new Hebrew names and repopulated with Zionist Jews. By July 1949 13,000 Palestinians had been killed and 78% of British Mandate Palestine was occupied by "Israel". Today that figure stands at well over 90%. See wikipedia.org/wiki/Nakba
